Students perform experiments, create models, and experience both the Scientific Method and the Engineering Design Process first hand. Our students participate in the Northern Indiana Regional Science Fair and You be the Chemist competition, as well as additional opportunities to explore science through our Camp Invention program.

Before receiving my license for Elementary Education with an endorsement in Middle School Science and Math, I was a substitute teacher for several years.
